

2. Prof. Keizo Kai Dies

It is our deep sorrow to announce you that Prof. Keizo Kai, Nobeyama Radio Observatory, National Astronomical Observatory, Japan, died on March 11, 1991 after eight months of hospitalization due to some very peculiar disease associated with allergy.
